

## OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), and the **Endorsement** pursuant to section 40, **BILANCIA LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell by remote sale alcohol from (but not on), the premises situated at 1 Cobden Road, Bluff Hill, Napier and known as "Bilancia Limited", to any person for consumption off the premises and to deliver it or have it delivered by some other person somewhere else.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

(a) Alcohol may be **sold**:

**At any time on any day**

- (b) The holder of the licence must ensure –
- (i) No alcohol may be **delivered** from the premises on Good Friday, or Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day; and
  - (ii) No alcohol may be **delivered** from the premises at any time on Easter Sunday unless it is grape wine or fruit or vegetables wine made on the premises or from produce harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
  - (iii) No alcohol may be **delivered** to the buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11pm on any day and before 6am on the next day.
- (c) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the license holder and on every receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
- (i) The licence holders name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires.
  - (ii) A copy of the licence, or a clearly identified link to such an image, must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site.
- (d) Pursuant to Regulations 14 and 15 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013:
- (i) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age.
  - (ii) The licensee when selling alcohol by remote sale via the Internet must comply with any regulations made under the Act requiring information to be visible on the holder's website when people browse, enter, or otherwise access it.
  - (iii) The licensee when selling alcohol by remote sale by mail order must comply with any regulations made under the Act requiring information to be published in the holder's catalogues.
  - (iv) The licensee when selling alcohol by remote sale by telephone must comply with any regulations made under the Act requiring information to be given to callers.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) Either—
- (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
- (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
